What relevant historical information has influenced these outcomes?

The history of Strontian holds huge significance when determining future outcomes. An understanding of the village through time supports investigation into the present story and future wishes for Strontian. Most notably, while the population of Strontian was in decline for many decades, it has stabilised and is now increasing.

What is happening next?

How have specific sites been selected and assessed?

The specific sites presented for discussion during the open community consultation were identified as publicly available land by the Strontian Development Steering Group. These sites were then explored by Rural Design Architects to uncover their constraints and opportunities, and these observations were presented to the consultation participants. Participants of the consultation were encouraged to give their feedback on these assessments and observations, and to add their own. They were also invited to come forward with any further information regarding potential available sites.

How have the priorities and outcomes for the village listed been determined?

The feedback from the residents of Strontian who participated in the open community consultation has been considered in parallel with the preparatory investigations undertaken by Rural Design Architects. To assist in clearly determining the priorities and outcomes of the village, an appraisal of the results of the community consultation was undertaken in conjunction with further appraisal of specific sites. Further sites and outcomes suggested during the consultation were included in this process. The following outcomes are therefore a reflection upon the collective participatory process.
